


SCOTCH NO SODA



Ofcourse we trust you know just what to do. So by all means, do your thing!

Some pointers stylewise:

We like to sound "60ies / 70ies vintage". So no need for up front, punchy or wide sounding drums. Even a simple mono overhead, kick and snare set-up could very well do the trick.

Micha will play both electric and upright acoustic bass. Each instrument has its own input in his amp. Maybe a DI from the upright bass' pick-up (with link to the amp) is handy. The bass amp itself has a DI out as well.

Gilles normally uses 2 guitar amps. 1 main and a second one for extra mojo in solo's.

Ilja's lead vocal is best with some slow compression and a short slapback delay.

Easy on the reverb please! Close to none is just fine.

Some favourite vocal mics are: M88, ND96, MD421...
